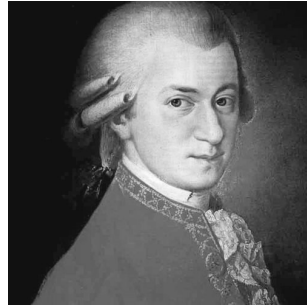

Mozart's Mass in C minor has been described as 'the only work to stand between Bach's *Mass in B minor* and Beethoven's *Missa Solemnis*'. Like Mozart's later Requiem, it is an unfinished work of breathtaking power, surrounded by mysterious personal associations. Written in 1782, the Mass was to fulfil 'a promise in my heart of hearts', following his marriage to Constanze Weber – a marriage that his father had bitterly opposed. This one-day workshop looks forward to a performance at Petersfield Musical Festival in 2024.



Paul Spicer is one of today's most distinguished choral conductors and is in great demand for his inspirational choral workshops. He conducts the Birmingham Bach Choir, is founder-director of the acclaimed Finzi Singers, and is Professor of Choral Conducting at the Royal Birmingham Conservatoire. He is a composer, writer and broadcaster, and a leading authority on twentieth-century British music. Paul has been Resident Conductor at Petersfield Musical Festival since 2005.



Bedales School Quad offers excellent facilities. The school is two miles from the A3 and has ample parking. Tiered seating for the choir ensures good visibility for all. Lunch is available, provided by the school's catering team.
